A Step-by-Step Guide

Keygold Recovery is simple to use: all you need is your broken computer, or the one holding the files you want to transfer, and the *Keygold Recovery* product to recover or lift and shift all your files. Print this Guide. You can repeat the *Keygold* process as often as you like.

STEP ONE – Put the CD in the CD drive and the USB Key into a working USB port. Turn your computer off and on.

The USB Key:



USB port ->

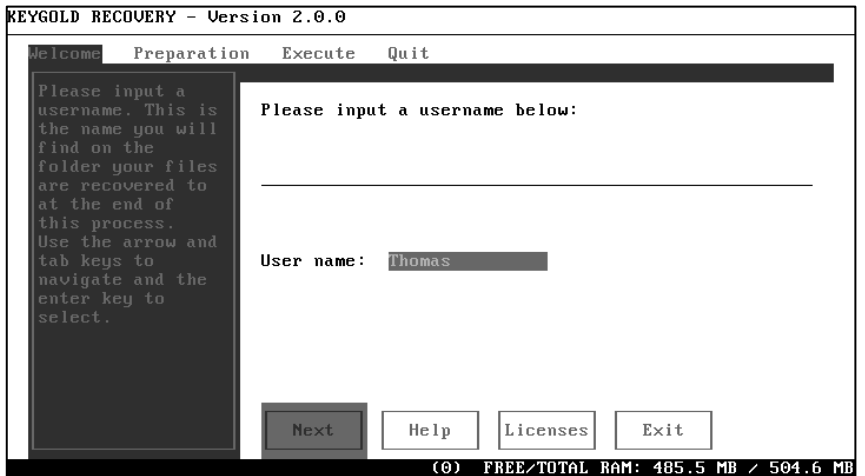
(on the side or back of a laptop

or at the back or front of a desktop)



When your computer turns on you will see a welcome screen and then you're at step two. If you don't see the welcome screen, open the BOOT HELP document.

STEP TWO – Input your username in the grey line. This can be any name you choose. Press ENTER.



Tip: Use your TAB (arrow) key to move around on the screen.

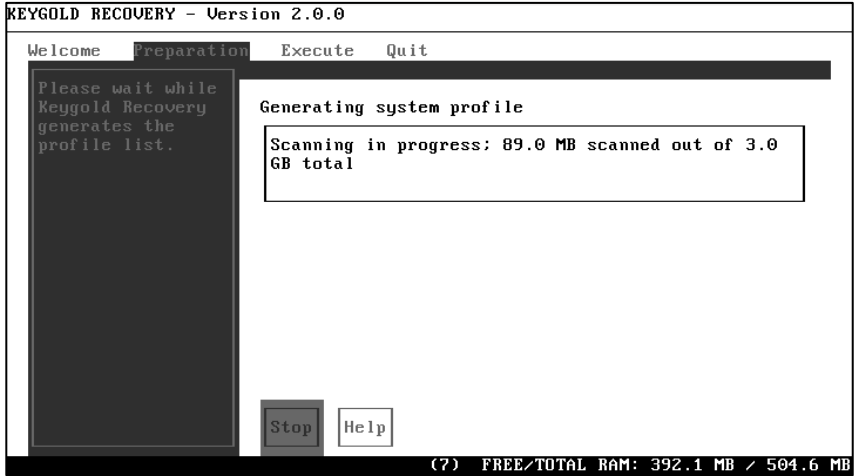
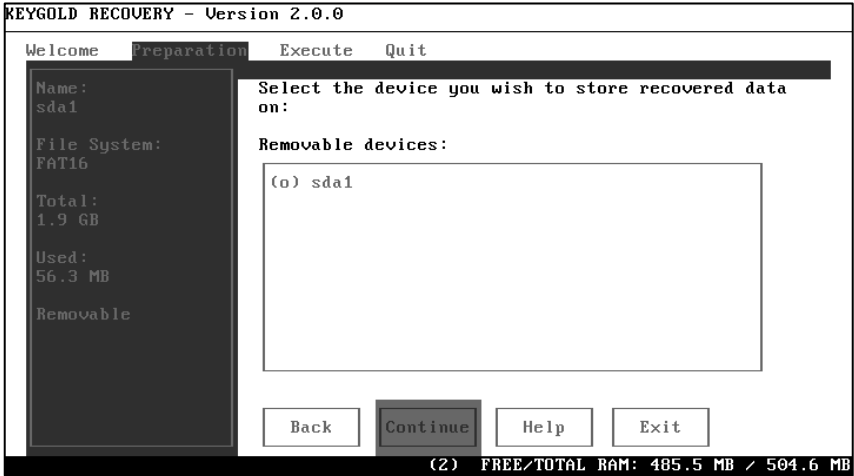
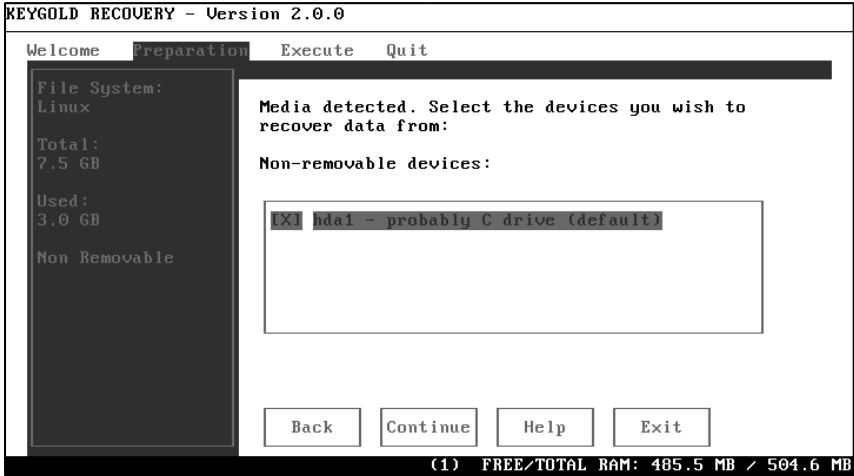


STEP THREE – Choose the drive you to recover your files from – Keygold Recovery will show you your choices. If you're not sure, select C. Press the SPACE bar to select it. Then press ENTER.

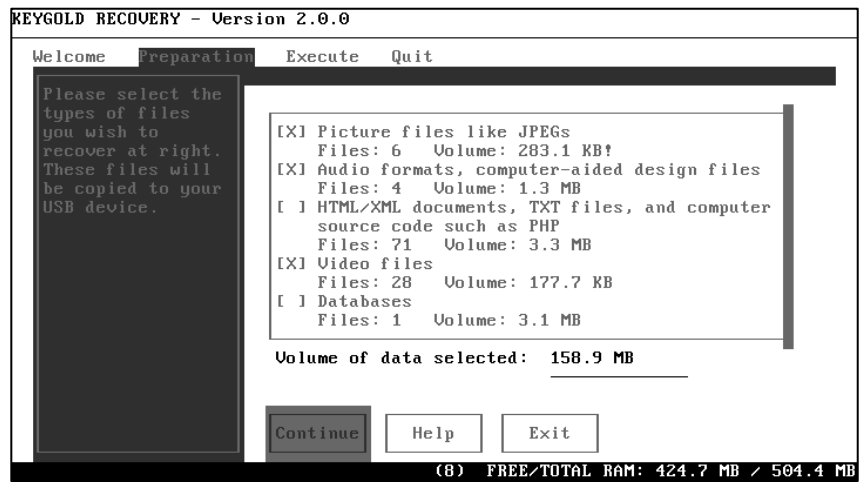


STEP FOUR – Choose the location to store the files – there's probably only the USB key indicated. Press ENTER.

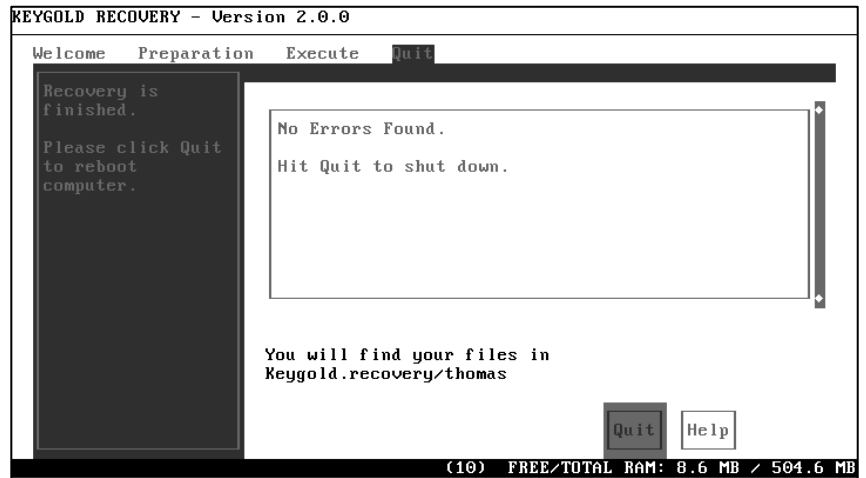
KEYGOLD RECOVERY IS WORKING – the time for the transfer depends on how many files you are copying.



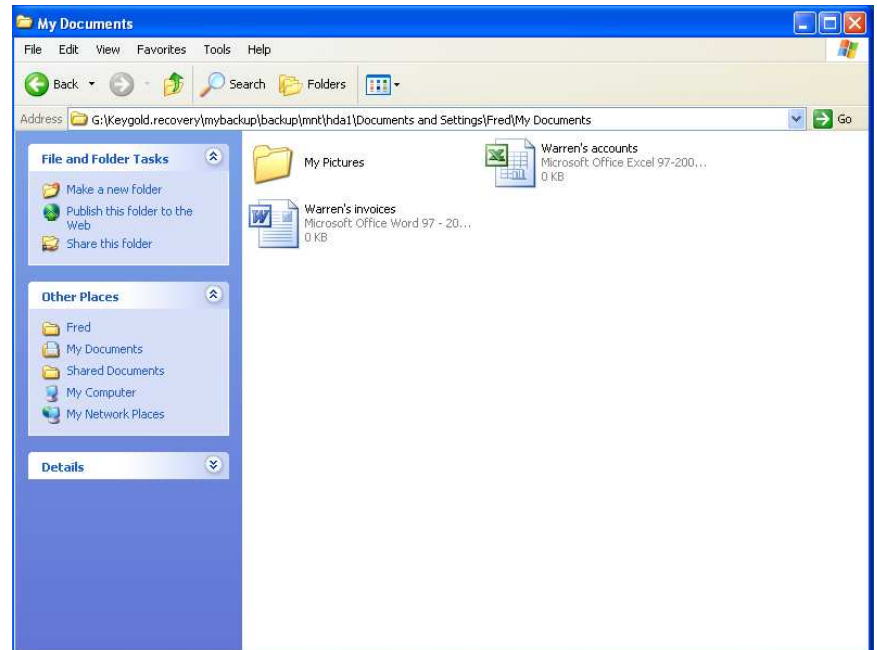
STEP FIVE – Select your preferred file types by using your TAB key to select the list of options in the large box at right, then use your UP/DOWN arrows to navigate. Press your SPACE BAR to select, then TAB back to the buttons at bottom. Select Continue and press ENTER.



TRANSFER COMPLETE! You will see this screen after the 'copying' screen, and you can then take your USB key to another computer to get the files. Press ENTER to quit.



FINAL STEP – The final step for you is to put your key into the computer where you want to see your files, and pull the files from the key onto that computer, or simply open them from the key.



FILE TYPES

Documents such as Word and Excel files

Documents, spreadsheets, and presentations from Microsoft Office and OpenOffice and other common word processor and spreadsheet applications, plus the contents of any folder with the word “tax” in it.

Email, including Outlook and Windows Mail

Email, plus your address books and contacts.

Picture files like JPEGs

Picture files like jpegs, photographs, contents of ‘My Pictures’, and other photo or camera file folders and contents.

Audio formats, computer-aided design files

Audio files such as MP3s will be recovered, plus playlists and CAD files such as those generated by AutoCAD.

HTML/XML documents, TXT files, and computer source code such as PHP

Web documents and PHP files will be recovered; Keygold focuses only on files you have generated yourself, so files found in your browser cache such as Temporary Internet Files will not be copied.

Video files

Video files including AVIs, WMVs, MP4s, mpg, SWF, and others.

Databases

Databases files such as those generated by Microsoft Access.

Compressed files

Files compressed into Zip or GZ format will be recovered.

Executable files outside Windows

If you have downloaded important installation files such as an installer for your antivirus and need to recover the installer package, select this category. Keep in mind this will NOT recover executable files found in Windows itself.

System files

It is safe to exclude this category from your recovery, as this is where system files are listed – files such as those found in the Windows folder or in Program Files will be retrieved. You cannot use these files to install applications – to do this you must use your original installation CDs or downloaded installation packages.
